



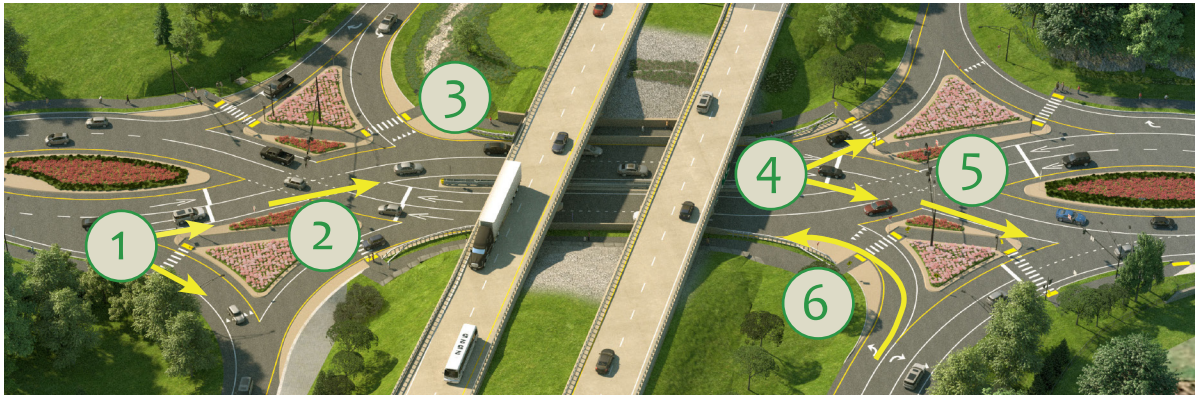
Exit 16 DDI

Diverging Diamond Interchange

Opening in September...

Vermont's first Diverging Diamond Interchange (DDI) at I-89 Exit 16 in Colchester is designed to improve mobility, reduce congestion, and enhance safety for motorists, bicyclists, and pedestrians along the US Routes 2/7 corridor, with traffic scheduled to transition to the new traffic pattern in September.

How to Navigate A DDI



- 1 **Approach the DDI** and choose whether to enter I-89 or continue on U.S. Routes 2/7.
- 2 **Cross to the left side of the roadway** at the first signalized intersection.
- 3 **Pedestrians and bicyclists** use the shared-use path and designated crosswalks to travel safely through the interchange.
- 4 **Choose your route** again, either entering I-89 or continuing on U.S. Routes 2/7.
- 5 **Cross back to the right side of the roadway** at the second signalized intersection.
- 6 **Drivers exiting I-89 who wish to turn left remain on the left side**, allowing for simpler left turns and convenient U-turns to re-enter I-89.
